LUPC has awarded a new agreement for Legal Services. The tender process was a collaborative exercise between all the English and Welsh higher education procurement consortia, with the participation and support of HE Shared Legal, the British Universities Finance Directors Group (BUFDG), Association of University Legal Practitioners (AULP), Universities HR and Association of University Directors of Estates (AUDE).

The agreement is split into six specialist lots, including Property (Estates); Human Resources (including Human Resources dispute resolution); Dispute resolution (all dispute resolution/ litigation except Human Resources dispute resolution); Governance (constitutional, charity, higher education, academic registry); Commercial; Student Matters; and a **One-stop-shop**.
